



The Franco-Chinese Institute DGUT / Cnam China

The Franco-Chinese Institute Cnam-DGUT was created in June 2017, by the Cnam in partnership with the Dongguan University of Technology (DGUT). This high-level higher education institution in the fields of engineering and technology aims to train engineers and specialized managers, while strengthening scientific exchanges and creating an efficient model of education.

This institute is the result of a long and patient work carried out by the Cnam and the DGUT, which began in November 2014, followed by a pedagogical and research project presented to the Chinese Ministry of National Education (EN) in 2016 and accredited on 27 February 2017.

Until 31 December 2029, this institute is thus authorized to receive up to 300 students per year.

Main disciplines

The Franco-Chinese Institute DGUT / Cnam China offers students in initial training a four-year Bachelor's degree in «Engineering Sciences».

This training is given in English, French and Chinese in three streams:

- Mechanics
- Information Technology
- Telecommunications

It delivers the BENKE diploma of the DGUT and the Cnam's Licence diploma.

The training is open to Chinese students admitted to the DGUT according to their score in the Gaokao (National university entrance exam in China). International students (students of non-Chinese nationality) can be admitted on the basis of a dossier via the DGUT.

Strong points

The Franco-Chinese Institute DGUT / Cnam China is more than just a new center abroad for the Cnam. It enables the Cnam to offer, beyond its borders, know-how in engineering training and lifelong learning and to respond actively to the demands of companies or to individual aspirations.

Located in an economically dynamic province, in a city halfway between Canton and Hong Kong, it is proof that the Institution's expertise is valued by foreign partners, including the most demanding ones.

Degrees awarded

- French National Diploma - General License
- Chinese Diploma - Benke (Bac+4)

French as a foreign language courses (FLE)

French courses are provided to prepare for the TCF (Test de Connaissance du Français). The B1/B2 level is expected at the end of the course.

English

Intensive English courses are provided during the L1 and L2 so that students can follow the scientific and technical courses taught in English from the 2nd semester of the L2.

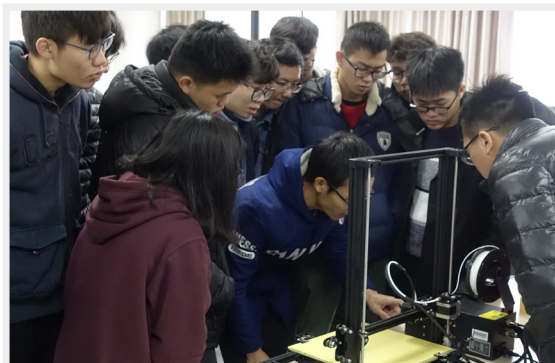
International students can apply for the following courses in English, full time:

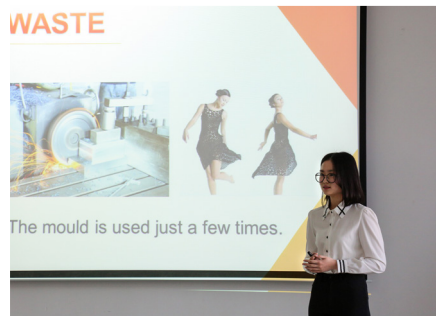


Fees
